The Municipal Council of Curepipe is inviting bids *from eligible bidders of Mauritian nationals or entities incorporated in Mauritius* through the Government eProcurement System for the provision of services for **Street Cleaning, Refuse Collection and Disposal including Carting Away of Post Cyclonic Waste for Municipal Council of Curepipe for a period of Thirty-Six Months for Housing Estates**

3. Bidders shall be registered with the Ministry of Local Government, Disaster and Risk Management as Scavenging Contractor. The procurement is being conducted through Open National Bidding procedures according to the provisions of the Mauritius Public Procurement Act 2006 as amended.

4. Bids must be submitted online on the eProcurement System at latest by **Wednesday 23 October 2024 up to 13.30 hours (Mauritian Time) at the latest.**

5. Bidders who have submitted bids online by the closing date and time shall decrypt and re-encrypt their bids on **Wednesday 23 October 2024 as from 14.31 hours (Mauritian Time) till Friday 25 October 2024 at 14.00 Hours (Mauritian Time).**

6. Bids will be opened online at the address given hereunder on **Friday 25 October 2024 from 14.01 hours up to 18.00 Hours (Mauritian Time) in the Conference Room of the Central Procurement Board, 1st Floor, Social Security House, Julius Nyerere Avenue, Rose Hill, Mauritius**

7. The *Municipal Council of Curepipe* reserves the right to accept or reject any bid and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of the Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to any Bidder.
